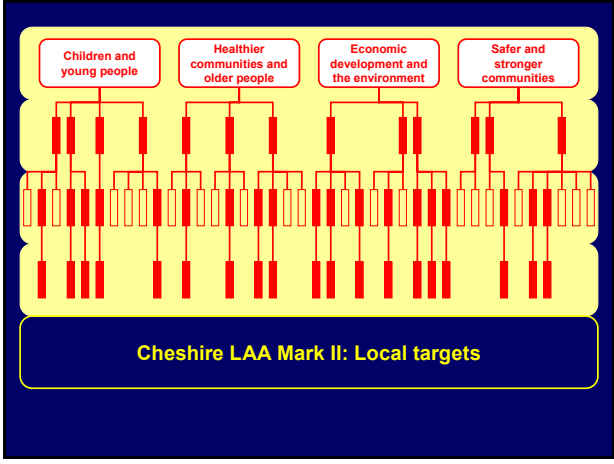


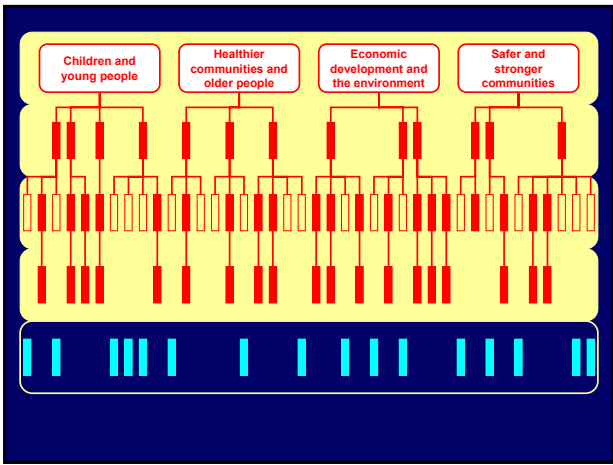


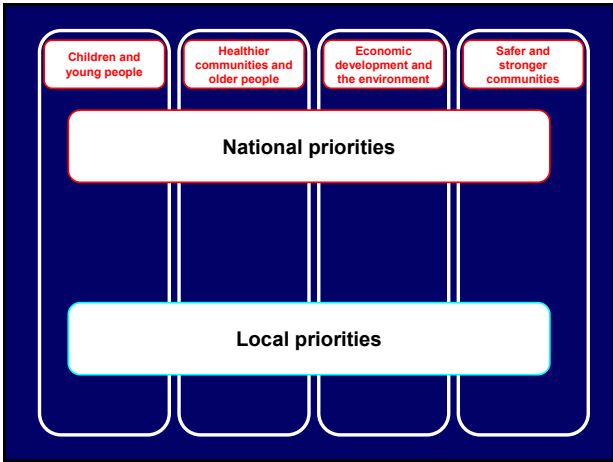


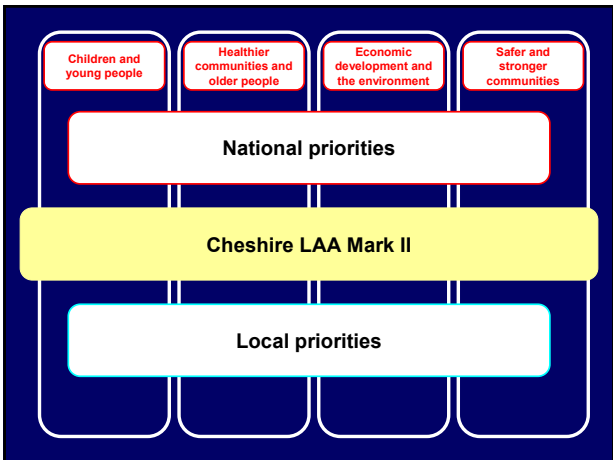


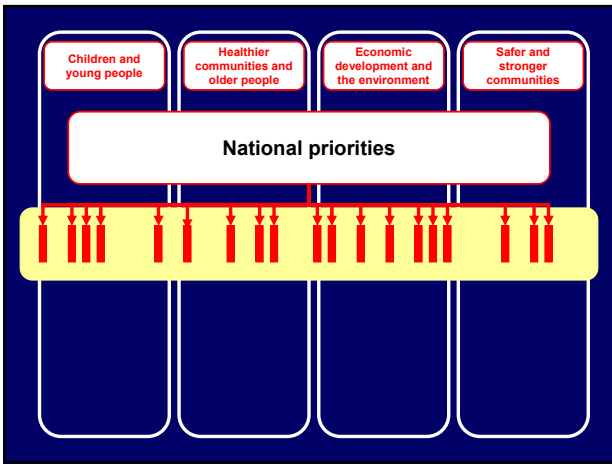


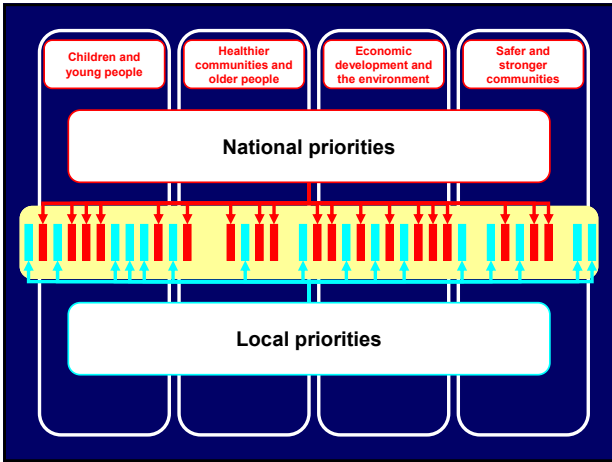








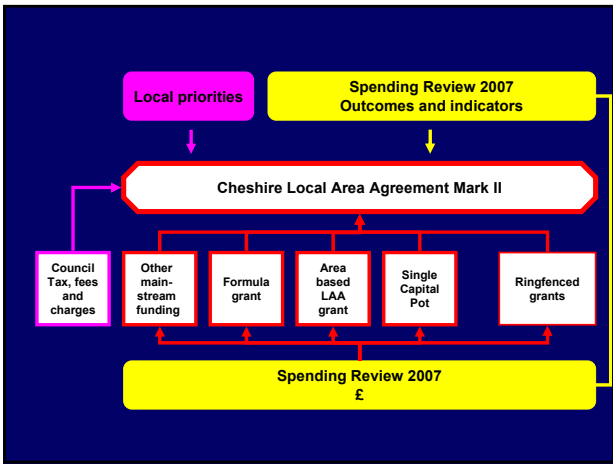


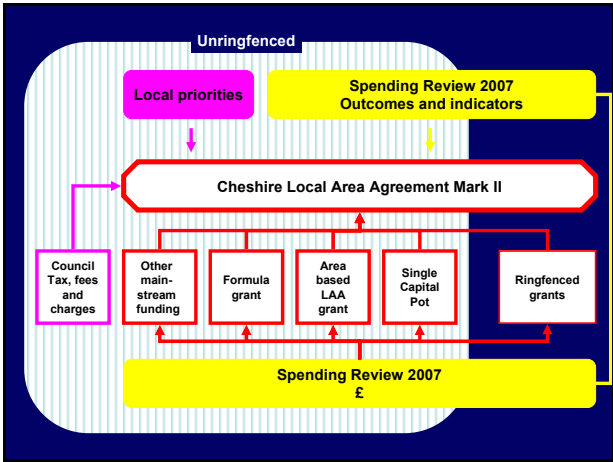


Finance
